School term dates

These are displayed on the notice board and our website, hard copies are also available if needed. Please note that our last day of this half term is **Friday 18th October**. We will be CLOSED for 1 week and return on **Monday 28th October**.

Government Funding

Just a reminder for working parents that we are still offering places for 30 hour funding. You can check if you are eligible by visiting **bromley.gov.uk** or search 'childcare choices'. There is also information regarding this on our notice board.

If you wish to take your child away for longer than 3 weeks, the Government funding will stop and you will have to pay fees to keep the place.

ALL parents:

Please remember to label all of your children's clothes, shoes, lunch boxes, snack boxes, water bottles and bags.

Fees:

If you pay fees, these still have to be paid even if your child is absent through illness, holidays or days off.

Please ensure that you bring / collect your child to / from pre-school on time each session they attend to avoid being charged. If you are going to be **late** or need to collect your child **early (before the session ends)**, please give us sufficient notice and / or arrange for someone else to collect your child if possible.

If you arrive early to collect your child, please wait until the session end time before pressing the bell and your child will be brought to the door. Thankyou.

Reminders for parents

Suitable weather clothing / shoes

Please ensure that your child is brought to pre-school in appropriate clothing and foot-wear. Open-toe sandals and flip-flops are not advised as a health and safety precaution.

When necessary, sun hats should be worn and sun-cream should be applied before bringing your child to pre-school with a named bottle left in your child's bag, should we need to top up in the hotter weather.

Healthy eating

We encourage packed lunches (and snacks) to contain a healthy range of foods that your child likes to eat. We do not advise sweets, cakes or chocolate during the school day. Please remember that we operate a 'nut free zone' policy and you must not provide any foods in packed lunches that contain nuts. This includes nutty spreads such as Nutella or peanut butter.

Parents providing snacks

Please can you place your child's snack inside the red crate, as the trolley is just for the children's lunch boxes.

Absence

If your child needs to be absent from preschool for *any* reason, please let us know by telephoning or sending us an email before their session is due to start.

If your child is absent due to sickness or diarrhea, you will need to keep them at home for **48 hours** from the last episode.

If your child has a temperature (fever over 37), they cannot return to pre-school until they have been fever free (unmedicated) for at least **24 hours**.
